We at **Kiwetinothk Energy Corp.** are passionate about the future of energy. Kiwetinothk's vision is to build a profitable business providing reliable, dispatchable and affordable energy. Kiwetinothk produces natural gas and related products and is a developer of renewable and natural gas-fired power projects, and early-stage carbon capture and storage projects. Kiwetinothk's petroleum producing properties include liquids-rich natural gas in the Fox Creek region of Alberta.

Kiwetinothk is currently seeking to fill the position of **Operations Support Worker in our trainee program**, located in **the Fox Creek area** and reporting to the **Production Coordinator, Upstream**. This position is **Full Time for the duration of the program (with potential to lead to a full-time permanent position) on a rotating schedule**. Most shifts will require staying in a camp in the area. It is possible that some time will be spent in other places for training and corporate activities. All safety gear will be provided.

The Trainee will gain a basic knowledge of plants, wells, pipelines and what is involved in keeping them operating safely and efficiently. Time will also be spent on introduction to health, safety and environment, emissions reporting, and asset retirement. The Operations Support Worker will also have tours of drilling and completions and construction activities as available. An introduction to specific trades (mechanics, electrical, instrumentation) will be completed as well.

The Operations Support Worker will be selected by Kiwetinothk Energy Corp. The successful candidate will be hired through Sturgeon Lake Resources.

Upon successful completion of the Operations Support Worker program, an Operations Support Worker may progress to become a full-time operator. After a period of time spent as an operator it is possible, if the desire exists, that person may attend a particular trade school with the support of Kiwetinothk Energy.

- Participate in daily activities with staff
- Gather general knowledge of facilities and area
- Acquire basic understanding of other services (drilling, completions, construction)
